6. Aria, Joy, and Lacy have been friends since childhood. Do you enjoy long-time friendships? What role do they play in your life?
7. Would you have handled Zander and Darcy's situation differently or the same way? How so?
8. Would you like to read a sequel to this book? If so, which characters would you like the author to include? More mystery or more romance?
9. Did this book make you want to read other books by this author?
