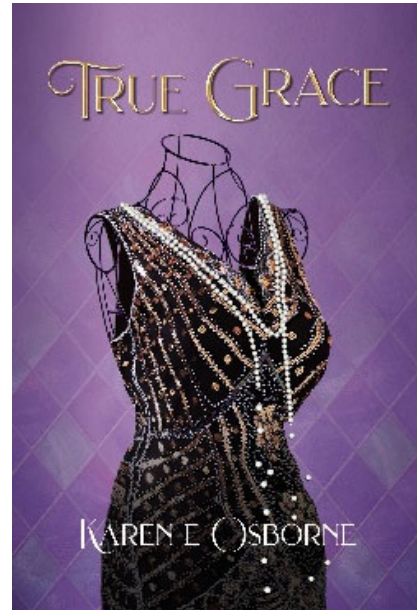


## Suggested Discussion Questions for *True Grace*

8. Would you have taken your daughter to Mrs. Kline if you were in Grace's shoes?
9. Grace repeated some of her parents' fraught decisions. Did you see alternatives given the circumstances and time?
10. Did this book make you want to read other books by this author?
